

# Club FAQs.

## What is the challenge?

It's the ultimate golf challenge to raise money for Cancer Council. A team of two or more players select their challenge length, complete it in one day and ask friends and family to sponsor them.

Challenge yourself to:

- The Long Day – 36 holes
- The Longer Day – 54 holes
- Or the ultimate challenge:  
The Longest Day – 72 holes

## What is involved?

The team will tee off at dawn, probably do the first two rounds fairly quickly, then play on until they finally complete that 72nd hole. Their friends and family might want to come and cheer them on. If they are completing a shorter challenge they won't need as much time on the course.

## When is it?

On or around 13 December – the longest day of the year. This is so they can make the most of the sunlight hours.

## What is it for?

Cancer Council is internationally renowned for innovative work in cancer research, prevention and support. Our mission is to prevent cancer, empower patients through providing information and support, and save lives. As an independent, not-for-profit organisation, we rely on the generosity of our supporters to continue our important work.

## What scoring system is used?

Participants play under the Stableford method and may also request carts. It's up to the club whether they provide carts for free or charge a fee. Some clubs have donated the fees to the teams' fundraising page.

## How can the club help?

**Sign up to be a Host Club and waive green fees** for all participants – they're taking on the ultimate challenge and raising funds for people impacted by cancer.

**Sign up to be a Promoter Club:**

**Open:** Encourage members and be open for non-members to take on the challenge for a fee.

**Members-only:** Private clubs encouraging members only to take on the challenge.

## On the day support?

It's recommended that the club make an announcement on the day to advise members that participants are taking on Cancer Council's The Longest Day challenge, playing 72 holes in one day to raise funds to help those impacted by cancer.
